

Host your event at Schumacher Farm Park and take inspiration from our beautiful prairie and the historic character that make the park a unique gem in Dane County. Our two facilities available for rent offer your choice of modern amenities or rustic appeal:

Center for Pural History

A modern barn structure with exposed beams and 1920s farm decor. It includes flush toilets, potable water, and a small kitchen area.

Historic Farmyard

An open air facility that includes access to the 1906 historic barn as well as the outdoor area surrounding the barn including the fire pit. Note: not available to rent November - March.

Center for Rural History

At approximately 1,200 square feet, the Prairie Room in the Center for Rural History (CRH) is ideal for smaller weddings, reunion, meetings, workshops, or social gatherings. The level and grassy barnyard on the south side of the building can be used for setting up tents to accommodate larger groups. The room offers a welcoming open space decorated with historical artifacts. Renters may bring their own decorations, but all decorations must be removable without any evidence of their placement.

The historic barn, built in 1906 by Henry Schumacher, is part of the rental of the historic farmyard. It has limestone walls, exposed wood beams, a concrete floor, subdued overhead lighting, and a small slightly raised stage. The structure is not temperature controlled and is not rated as handicapped accessible, although it is on the ground level. Two of its three doors must remain open to meet fire safety regulations. The farmyard area surrounding the historic barn has picnic tables, a fire pit, trash receptables, and pit toilets. The space is great for open air events during the fair-weather months. Many people enjoy holding their wedding ceremonies or small group activities in this special historic space.

Seating Capacity:

• The interior of the barn can fit up to 30 people comfortably on bench seating. Renters may request standard tables or hay bales in addition to or in place of benches.

Amenities included in rental:

- Subdued overhead lighting
- A small slightly raised stage
- Electrical outlets in the barn
- Bench seating in the barn
- Picnic tables in the farmyard
- An outdoor fire pit
- Trash receptacles

Please note that the following amenities are not available in the Historic Farmyard: heat, air conditioning, drinking water, flush toilets, and AV equipment. All park users have access to modern restroom facilities in the Center for Rural History during open park hours (typically 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.).
